

## **Vendor COVID-19 Guidelines**

### **Mandatory Guidelines**

Vendors will be spaced 6' apart.

Tablecloths should be nonporous materials that can be wiped down frequently or use no table cloth.

No sampling will be permitted at the market.

Vendors may display produce/products on tables but may not permit any customers to touch the products.

Vendors will be required to wear masks.

If vendors are wearing gloves, they are required to change them between transactions when handling money and/or credit cards or otherwise coming in contact with items a customer may have touched.

If vendors are not wearing gloves, they are required to sanitize their hands between transactions when handling money and/or credit cards or otherwise coming in contact with items a customer may have touched.

Vendors will change gloves after any time they touch their face or body.

Vendors are required to sanitize their hands after they touch their face or body.

The market will have lines drawn requiring customers to maintain a 6 foot distance from all vendor booths. Vendors may set up a table between their booth and the customer area to pass products to customers. These tables must be sanitized frequently.

Vendors who are cooking on site will take customers orders, instruct customers to finish their shopping, exit the market, and pick up their order at a designated area at the back of their canopy, maintaining social distancing at all times.

Vendors will not be permitted to place items in a customer's reusable shopping bag.

Vendors will be responsible for sanitizing tables and surfaces at their stand at least once every hour.

Vendors will not be permitted at the market if they are sick.

## **Suggested Guidelines**

One person at a vendor stall will be designated to handle money and another will be designated to hand purchased items.

Vendors are encouraged to set-up online payment systems, such as Venmo and PayPal and display signage instructing customers how to use the payment methods.

Vendors are encouraged to set-up online pre-ordering for pickup at the market.

Vendors are encouraged to pre-package/pre-weigh produce.

Please know that these guidelines are to keep everyone safe and healthy so we can continue to operate the market while social distancing guidelines are set by our local, state, and federal government.
